



Assistant Professor / Department of Public and Nonprofit Administration

The Department of Public and Nonprofit Administration in the School of Urban Affairs and Public Policy at the University of Memphis invites applicants for a tenure track appointment at the rank of Assistant Professor beginning fall 2020. Responsibilities include teaching, research, and outreach in our Master of Public Administration program with concentrations in Nonprofit Administration and Public Management/Policy (www.memphis.edu/padm for more information).

The successful candidate should have specializations in one of the two following areas:

Nonprofit Management: Candidates with active research agendas in all areas of nonprofit management research will be considered, and candidates whose research focuses on advocacy, social movements, philanthropy or any area of nonprofit finance are especially encouraged to apply. Candidates should be able to offer one or more core courses and contribute to courses in the nonprofit specialization. Candidates must have an earned doctorate in public administration, public policy, nonprofit management or a related field by time of appointment.

OR

Public Management: Candidates with active research in all areas of public management and policy will be considered, and candidates whose research focuses within the urban context, including local government, performance, or local public economies, are especially encouraged to apply. Candidates should be able to offer one or more core courses and contribute to courses in public management. The successful candidate should demonstrate the potential for excellence in teaching and research and an enthusiasm for community-based engagement. Candidates must have an earned doctorate in public administration, public policy, nonprofit management or a related field by time of appointment.

To ensure full consideration, applications should be received by October 21, 2019. Submit a cover letter of interest, vita, transcripts, and names and contact information for three references.
